Tournament Rules

- * This tournament is not CYSA or US Club sanctioned. We have our own insurance through Olympus Sports Coliseum so CYSA or US Club paperwork is not required. The honor system is used to monitor that players are playing in the correct age group. You are not required to play on the same team as you do with CYSA or US Club
- * There must be four (4) teams in an age group to have that division.
- * This is a round robin tournament.
- * U8 goals on a U8 playing field.
- * A 12-player roster will be used. The 12-player roster needs to be designated prior to the teams' scheduled first game.
- * Players are not permitted to play on multiple teams in the same age group.
- * Players are not permitted to play below their age level
- * Games will start at the scheduled time.
- * Games are 2 x 20 minute halves (no injury time). With a two-minute halftime.
- * All fouls outside of the penalty area will be indirect. Fouls inside of the penalty area, that are of direct nature, will result in a penalty kick (10 yards).
- * Goal kicks are not to be kicked over half field without touching another player or the ground
- * Balls played out of bounds will be restarted by throw in, goal kick, or corner kick.
- * Goalkeepers cannot distribute over the half-line while within the arc. Distribution must be touched by a player or the ground before going over the half-line.
- * In event of a Red Card, the player's team that received the Red Card will play short for the remainder of the game, in addition the player receiving the Red Card will have to sit out the follow game at a minimum.
- * Ties will stand in round robin play
- * Ball can be played backward off the kick off.
- * Subs are made on the fly. The player being subbed must be running toward the sideline before the entering player can step on.
- * No offside rule.
- * The HOME TEAM will change uniform colors if we have a conflict!!
- * Any other discrepancies will be ruled on by the tournament directors.
