Financial Responsibility and Obligations

REGISTRATION / UNIFORMS: Your upfront fees are registration fees which include a uniform fees; fees are \$250.00 per player. The uniforms will consist of Two uniforms (top and bottoms) one light and one dark, warm up shirt, hoodie, duffle bag, and game day socks. (Additional \$100 Fee), gear available for purchase separately).

Tournaments: We ask that you are prepared to pay an additional \$15-\$30 per Player per local tournament. Large tournaments such as Nationals can run at a higher cost. Fees are due one (1) week prior to the Friday before a Tournament.

Traveling & Game Expenses: All costs associated with travel to tournaments such as uniforms, transportation, parents and fan admission to games, food and hotel stay are the players family's responsibilities and are not included in the seasonal fees.

Skills Camp / Playing Time

Skills Camp: Tryouts will be held June 23rd, 2018 11:30-1pm Tryout fees are \$10 a player

Playing Time: We are not a recreational league and are not bound by any playing time minimums. Players must prove in practice and during the game that they want playing time. Playing time is earned and not given, though this may sound harsh but in order to teach the importance of earing what you desire, we will reserve the right to limit the playing time of a player who does not demonstrate a desire to play.

Missed Practice: This is typically going to be at the coach's discretion. However; when an athlete does not attend practice it harms the entire team. Therefore; if an athlete fails to make practice during the week of a tournament the coach can determine the athlete ineligible to play in the tournament. This is a huge commitment please ensure you are communicating with coaches any commitment or attendance issues you may have in advance.
